

The Difference between Spot Marking and Line Marking Paint

PRODUCT GUIDE



Spot Marking and Line Marking Paint are often confused due to their similar appearance; however they are designed for different applications. This product guide will go through the specifications of both and some FAQs to help you make the right choice.

Spot Marking Paint Specifications:

- 350g can with a unique trigger cap for easy marking
- Available in 8 fluoro and 7 standard colours
- Can be used on bitumen, dirt, concrete and timber surfaces
- Ideally used for marking out road works, building sites and golf courses
- Can be used by hand or with the Signet marking spray applicator (Item#11400)



FAQs:

- **How long will Spot Marking Paint last?**
 - Fluoro Colours: 3-6 Months
 - Standard Colours: 6-12 Months
- **I need to remove Spot Marking Paint, how do I do this?**
 - This could be different on a case-by-case basis; however generally Graffiti Remover, Acetone or Methylated Spirits will work on most surfaces
- **My can of Spot Marking Paint isn't working or spraying, what can I do?**
 - You will need to shake the can for 30 seconds from when the ball rattles as the paint may have settled
 - After each use you will need to clear the chamber to avoid the can clogging. You can do this by turning the can upwards and spraying until the spray is clear

Line Marking Paint Specifications:

- Large 500g can and a unique spray actuator only available from Signet
- High UV resistance and fast drying
- Can be used on concrete, bitumen, timber and even grass (Turf Marking Paint only)
- Ideal for marking out car parks, warehouses and sporting grounds
- Can be used by hand or with the Signet line marking trolley (Item#21501)

FAQs:

- **How long does Line Marking Paint last?**
 - 2-3 years depending on various factors such as weather and traffic
- **How much paint will I get out of one can of Line Marking Paint?**
 - 1 can = 80 - 100m (Depending on various factors)
- **Can I use Signet Line Marking Paint in another trolley?**
 - The Signet paint cans have a unique actuator cap which will give the best performance in the Signet trolley. However the cans can be used in certain other models of trolleys that have a rectangle shaped actuator hole. Signet Line Marking cans have 2 parallel ridges on top of the actuator that will fit down into this shape actuator hole
- **How long does Line Marking Paint take to dry?**
 - Signet Line Marking Paint is fast drying as it only takes 5-6 minutes to completely dry
