

How to Mark a Sports Oval with Field Marking Paint

HOW TO GUIDE



Field Marking Paint is an easy and effective way of marking out a sporting field. This guide will go through the reasons to choose Field Marking Paint over an alternative, instructions for application as well as some helpful tips.

Why use Field Marking Paint?

- If you are marking a grass sporting oval
- To achieve the best looking lines for the field
- If you are currently using aerosol cans and are looking for a more cost effective solution
- If you are environmentally conscious and want to use a water-based product
- If you already have or want to use a Field Marking Trolley



How do I prepare the paint?

Step 1

Get another empty bucket to mix the paint in

Step 2

Pour desired amount of Field Paint into the empty bucket (e.g. 1 litre)

Step 3

Add 4 litres of water for every 1 litre of Field Paint that you use

Step 4

Stir the mixture well (30 seconds recommended)

Step 5

Pour the mixed product into your Field Marking Machine

Step 6

Mark the fields using the Field Marking Machine

Helpful Tips:

- Use Signet Spot Marking spray to help with the initial outlay
- Use string line to set-out your lines
- Using string line & a post pushed into the ground will help set-out any circles required
- The paint is water & light fast so it won't wash away or fade. To remove it you will need to mow the grass
- Depending on various factors, one bucket will usually enable you to mark 3 – 4 fields
- To get an even whiter & brighter line use a higher paint ratio e.g. 3 parts water to 1 part paint
- For optimal lines, we recommends going forwards & backwards over the line to coat both sides of the blades of grass
- On big game days, the different Field Marking Paint colours can be used on the lines/in goal areas to show extra support for your team
- Never use the paint concentrate to mark – ensure you always add water
- If the drum is unopened, concentrated paint will last up to 3 years
- Once opened and diluted we do not recommend storing leftover paint. It doesn't have a lasting storage life
